Annual Spring Clean-Up Begins May 4th

The Borough's annual Spring Clean-Up schedule has been set giving residents an opportunity to get rid of household junk items. This year's schedule will be **Zone #1 – May 4th**, **Zone #2 – May 18th**, and **Zone #3 May 25th**. The deadline to register for the clean-up is the Friday before the scheduled day for each zone. Only single and double family residential properties who are current Borough trash collection customers are eligible to participate in the program. Items that are not taken during the clean-up include tires, construction debris such as shingles/roofing materials, drywall, wood boards, ceiling tiles, flooring

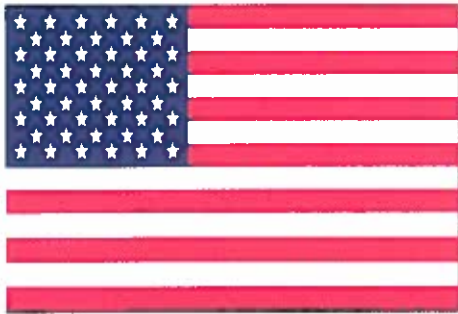

CURBSIDE YARD RECYCLING BEGINS IN APRIL 9th

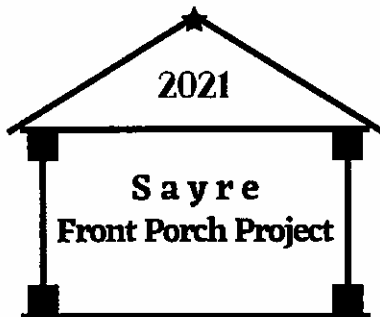
The curbside collection of yard waste and brush begins in April and continues through October. Yard waste and brush will be collected on the second Friday of each month in Zones #1 & #2 and the third Friday of each month in Zone #3.

Residents should only place their items at the curblines the day before the scheduled collection day, and items can be taken to the South Thomas Avenue drop-off center on Mondays and Wednesday from 4:00pm – 7:00pm and Saturdays from 8:00am – 3:00pm beginning April 1st. Please use bags or containers for leaves and yard waste, and bundle branches and limbs in four (4') foot lengths.

- **Second Week of Each Month** – Area of the Borough bordered by Hayden Street – Athens Borough Line – South Lehigh Avenue – South Keystone Avenue
- **Third Week of Month** – Area of the Borough west of Keystone Avenue
- **Fourth Week of Month** – Milltown & Eastside
- **Every Friday** – Downtown Area / Brock Street / West Lockhart Street
