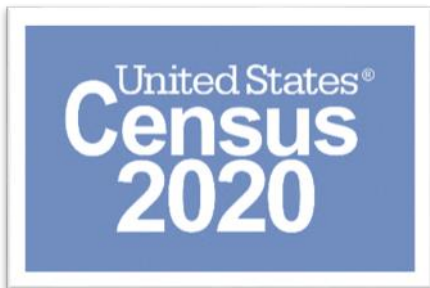


# SAYRE BOROUGH NEWS SPRING 2020

The 2020 U.S. Census is fast approaching with less than 50 days until it officially gets under way, and Pennsylvania officials and the U.S. Census Bureau have been planning ahead for the decennial count for years now. Beginning April 1, officially dubbed "Census Day," every household in the country will have received an invitation to participate in the 2020 Census. The Census will provide a snapshot of our nation's population, and the results are vitally important to our state. This once-a-decade federal

requirement generates information that helps businesses, researchers, and communities make important decisions. It also determines congressional representation, and is used to direct hundreds of billions in federal funding to communities nationwide for hospitals, fire departments, school lunch programs, and other critical programs and services.

## **Annual Spring Clean-Up Begins April 28<sup>th</sup>**



The Borough's annual Spring Clean-Up schedule has been set giving residents an opportunity to get rid of household junk items. This year's schedule will be **Zone #1 – April 28<sup>th</sup>, Zone #2, May 5<sup>th</sup>, and Zone #3 May 19<sup>th</sup>**. Only single and double family residential properties who are current Borough trash collection customers are eligible to participate in the program. Items that are not taken during the clean-up include tires, construction debris such as shingles/roofing materials, drywall, wood boards, ceiling tiles, flooring materials, electronics and propane/gas cylinders. **CLEAN-UP REGISTRATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE AT**

## SPRING 2020



Residents are reminded that corrugated cardboard must be recycled and not placed out for trash collection. Corrugated cardboard can be identified by looking for the ridges inside the layers of the corrugated cardboard box. Break down boxes and keep dry. Do not mix with paperboard boxes such as cereal boxes, pasta boxes, tissue boxes, etc. Corrugated cardboard that is placed out for trash collection will not be collected.



### CURBSIDE YARD RECYCLING BEGINS IN APRIL

The collection of yard waste and brush begins in April and continues through October. Yard waste and brush will be collected on April 17<sup>th</sup> in Zones #1 & #2, and on April 24<sup>th</sup> in Zone #3. Beginning in May and continuing through October, collection will take place on the second Friday of each month for residents living in Zones #1 & #2, and on the third Friday of the month in Zone #3. Residents should only place their items at the curblines the day before the scheduled collection day, and items can be taken to the South Thomas Avenue drop-off center on Mondays and Wednesday from 4:00pm – 7:00pm and Saturdays from 8:00am – 3:00pm beginning April 1<sup>st</sup>. Please use bags or containers for leaves and yard waste, and bundle branches and limbs in four (4') foot lengths.

## Street Sweeping Schedule

The Borough's street sweeper hit the road early this year and the schedule will be the same as in previous years with the streets being divided into four zones as described below and the downtown area will be swept every Friday;

- **First Week of Each Month** – Area of the Borough bordered by West Lockhart Street - Mohawk Street – North Lehigh Avenue – North Keystone Avenue
- **Second Week of Each Month** – Area of the Borough bordered by Hayden Street – Athens Borough Line – South Lehigh Avenue – South Keystone Avenue
- **Third Week of Month** – Area of the Borough west of Keystone Avenue
- **Fourth Week of Month** – Milltown & Eastside
- **Every Friday** – Downtown Area / Brock Street / West Lockhart Street
